As all our Everyman's and Everywoman's REPs in the field are unpaid volunteers, the ADF is hopeful despite that, we will still be able to step up for them, as we have done in years gone by. This may even mean deploying on overseas operations with Defence into dangerous areas, as we did on the Malay Peninsula in 1942, and through many other conflicts since. 

I was born in Brazil in a family where my father followed Spiritism and my mother was an atheist.


